

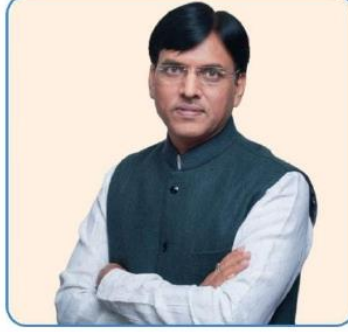

I feel honoured and privileged to present the 3rd Annual Report and Audited Statements of Accounts for the year 2022-23 of AIIMS Jammu.

AIIMS Jammu made progress in all facets towards Commissioning of the Institute. During the period from 01st April 2022 to 31st March 2023, a total of seventy (70) regular faculty members, sixteen (16) Nursing Officers and two (02) Non-Faculty staff joined AIIMS Jammu.

The 3rd Batch of MBBS Students consisting of 61 students also joined AIIMS Jammu in the month of December 2022. The Academic progress of 1st and 2nd batch of MBBS students has been good and they are also being encouraged to participate in research activities.

The CPWD made significant progress in the construction of the 42 Towers. HITES who is a PSA (Procurement Supply Agency) for Medical Equipment for AIIMS Jammu supplied 97 NoAs (out of 786) for Plug & Play Equipment and 04 (out of 13) for Turnkey Equipment during the period 01st April 2022 to 31st March 2023.

A MoU was signed between AIIMS Jammu and Rashtriya Ayurveda Vidyapeeth (National Academy of Ayurveda), an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Ayush, Government of India on 20th April 2022 for undertaking joint research projects.

First Meetings of the Standing Hospital Affairs Committee (SHAC) and Standing Estate Committee (SEC) of AIIMS Jammu were conducted on 02nd December 2022. Introduction:

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaypur, Jammu is one amongst the several new AIIMS, being established under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. The short-term objective of establishing new AIIMS in various parts of India is to reduce the 'gaps' in affordable Tertiary Healthcare and long-term vision is to generate 'wellness' amongst the general population of India. AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu is under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). It came into existence as an Institute of National Importance through Central Government Gazette Notification dated 04th December 2019. Establishment of AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu has been done under PMSSY (Phase-V) in a bid to correct regional imbalance in availability of affordable /reliable Tertiary Healthcare services and to cater for people residing in far flung areas of UT of Jammu & Kashmir, adjoining regions of Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and rest of the country.

The trinity of mission of AIIMS is:

1. Education of diverse health professionals
2. Research in biomedical sciences; and
3. Patient care at the highest care level

The objectives of AIIMS as mentioned in the AIIMS Act 1956 (as amended) are as follows:-

1. To develop patterns of teaching in under-graduate and post graduate medical education in all its branches so as to demonstrate a high standard of medical education to all medical colleges and other allied Institutions of India.
2. To bring together in one place education facilities of the highest order for the training of personal in all branches of health activities.
3. To attain self-sufficiency in post-graduate medical education.

AIIMS Jammu is presently under construction and is likely to be commissioned in January 2024.

Governance Structure: The Governance structure is depicted in figure-1

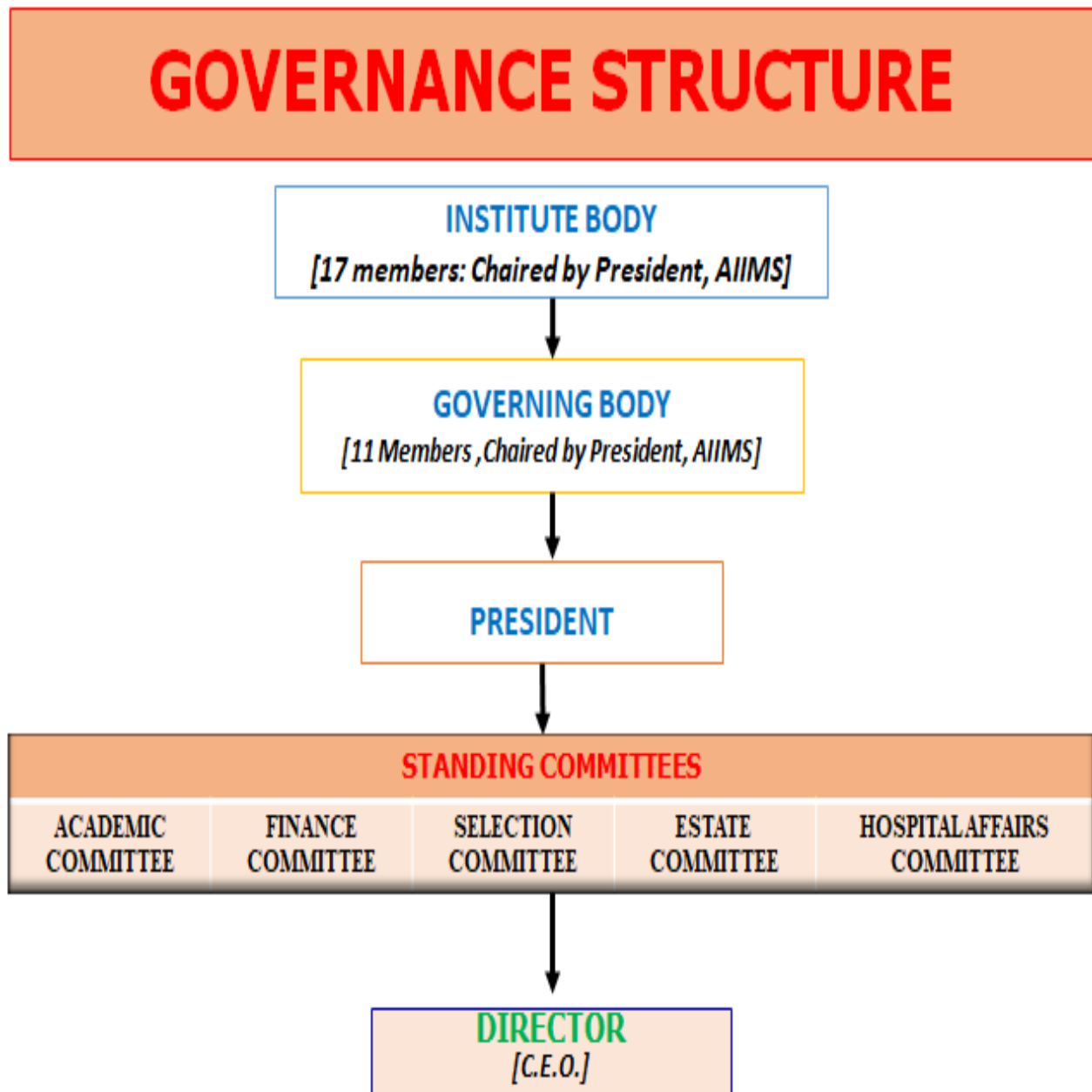


Figure -1: Governance Structure

Separate Audit Report of Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the accounts of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaypur, Jammu for the year ended 31st March 2023.

We have audited the Balance Sheet of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaypur, Jammu as at 31 March 2023, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with section 18(2) of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Act 1956. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Institute's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/ CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidences supporting the amounts and disclosure in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that:

- i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
- ii) The Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account/Receipts and Payments Account dealt with by this Report have been drawn up in the uniform format prescribed by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India vide order no. 29-4/2012-FD dated 17 April, 2015.
- iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been maintained by the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaypur, Jammu in so far as it appears from our

examination of such books.

iv) We further report that:

A. Balance Sheet:

A.1 Earmarked/Endowment Fund (Schedule-3):

Interest: Rs. 5.47 crore

Above represents the interest earned during the period 2019-20 to 2022-23 by the institute on the grants received from government of India. In this regard, a reference is invited to General Financial Rule No. 230(8) as per which, all interests or other earnings against Grants in aid or advances (other than reimbursement) released to any Grantee institution should be mandatorily remitted to the Consolidated Fund of India immediately after finalization of the accounts. The institute has booked the above mentioned interest earned under Earmarked/Endowment Funds instead of treating it as a liability, which is not in order.

This has resulted in overstatement of Earmarked/Endowment Funds and understatement of Current Liabilities by Rs. 5.47 crore (1.86+0.41+3.20). Similar comment was also issued in the Separate Audit Report for the previous years in respect of Interest amounting Rs. 3.20 crore. However, compliance for the same was not made.

Further, note at Sr. 2 incorrectly stated that Interest received/accrued during the year amounting to Rs. 2.27 (0.27+1.59+0.41) crore as well as interest for the period 2020-21 & 2021-22 amounting to Rs. 1.85 & 1.35 crore respectively has been transferred from Capital Fund to Current Liabilities.

B General

B.1 A reference is invited to policy at Sr. No. 4 wherein it was stated that no provision has been made during the year for retirement benefits of employees. This is contrary to Accounting standard-15 of ICAI as well as prescribed format.

B.2 Fixed Assets (Schedule 8)

The Fixed Assets (schedule 8) has been prepared in contravention to guidelines prescribed by Ministry of Finance as details given below:

- (i) The Gross block of Fixed Assets as on 01.04.2022 has been shown after deducting the depreciation.
- (ii) The capital work in progress (CWIP) was not shown separately. However, CWIP was included in total cost of Fixed Assets.
- (iii) Previous year corresponding figures were not depicted.

B.3 Depreciation (Schedule 8): NIL

The depreciation amounting to Rs. 36.87 lakh was charged on fixed assets during 2022-23 which has been shown under Fixed Assets- schedule 8 and the depreciation for Rs. 36.81 lakh has been adjusted against corpus/capital fund directly by way of making deduction from the fixed assets under schedule 1. It should have been routed through Income and Expenditure Account as per the prescribed format. However, necessary disclosure in this regard has also been made in the notes to accounts.

C. Grants-in-Aid

C.1 The position of grant- in -aid of the institute as on 31.03.2023 was as under:

C.2 In Schedule-3, closing balance of Grant in Aid (OH31) amounting to Rs. 5.51 crore was depicted instead of Rs. 5.84 crore as the difference of Rs. 0.33 (5.84-5.51) crore is due to taking of opening balance of Grant in Aid (OH31) amounting to Rs. 0.51 crore instead of Rs. 0.85 crore as worked out in previous year SAR (2021-22). This difference needs to be reconciled.

D. Management letter

Deficiencies which have not been included in the Audit report have been brought to the

notice of the Institute's management through a management letter issued separately for remedial/corrective action.

v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the Accounting Policies and Notes on Accounts, and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in Annexure to this Audit Report give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- a. In so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaypur, Jammu as at 31 March 2023; and
- b. In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account, of the deficit for the year ended on that date.

Part B. Other irregularities noticed during the audit of accounts of the institute for the year 2022-23 which have not been included in Separate Audit Report.

B.1 Other Administrative Expenses -Schedule 21.

Printing and Stationery: Rs. 11.50 lakh

Above wrongly included Books & Periodicals amounting to Rs. 0.76 lakh. These should have been booked under Fixed Assets. This has resulted in understatement of Fixed Assets by Rs. 0.46 lakh as well as depreciation by Rs. 0.30 lakh (Schedule 4) and overstatement of “Other Administrative Expenses” (Schedule 21) by Rs. 0.76 lakh.

B.2 Other Administrative Expenses (Schedule 21)

Hiring of manpower: Rs. 3.75 crore

Above includes Rs. 3.75 crore being the expenditure incurred on hiring of manpower. Keeping in view the nature of expenditure, the abovementioned expenditure should have been disclosed under the head ‘Establishment Expenses’. Accounting Policy as regards the classification of temporary staff under ‘Other Administrative Expenses’ instead of ‘Establishment Expenses’ has

not been disclosed. This observation was raised in the previous year SAR. However compliance has not been made.

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



SCHEDULE 24: SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. Accounting Convention

1.1 The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on accrual method of accounting.

2. Revenue Recognition

2.1 Grants in Aid (GIA) have been accounted for on receipt basis.

The accounting treatment of Government Grants has been made on the basis of nature of grants received. Accordingly, the Capital Grants have been accounted for following the Capital Approach & Revenue grants have been accounted for following the Income Approach as per the procedures prescribed in AS-12, "Accounting for Government Grants" issued by ICAI. Revenue Grants have been booked as income to the extent expended during the year.

2.2 Interest earned has not been recognised as income as the same is refundable to GOI.

3. Fixed Assets & Depreciation

A) Fixed Assets





2. Interest earned on deposits with State Bank of India during the financial year amounting to Rs. 27,26,861 & accrued interest on deposits amounting to Rs. 1,59,41,102 have been reflected under the head Current Liabilities during the current year as the same is transferable to GOI in terms of GFR Rule No 230(8).

Interest amount transferred during the year from AIIMS Rishikesh amounting to Rs. 41,30,141 has been reflected under the head current liabilities.

Similarly, in order to rectify the observation as pointed out in Point B of SAR for the year 2021-22, interest earned during the year 2020-21 & 2021-22 amounting to Rs.1,84,59,254 & 1,34,91,736 respectively has been transferred from Capital Fund and shown under the head current liabilities during the current year.



3. Assets amounting to Rs 2,09,20,847 have been purchased during the year through Capital Grant. Depreciation amounting to 36,87,436 has been charged on the said assets which has been written off through Capital/Corpus Fund.
4. Application fees for recruitment of Senior Residents amounting to Rs 215101 have been received during the year. The same is being reflected under the Current Liabilities since the recruitment process for which the fees have been received was later cancelled and accordingly the fees will have to be refunded to the applicants.
5. Interest paid on HEFA Loan during the year 2021-22 amounting to Rs. 2,08,65,826 has been debited to work in Progress and reversed from Capital Fund in order to rectify the observation as pointed out in Point A.2 of SAR for the year 2021-22.
6. CPWD is constructing the building of AIIMS at Vijaypur, (J&K). The funds amounting to Rs.879,99,00,000/- for construction of building have been directly transferred by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to CPWD. An amount of Rs.50 crores also stands transferred from AIIMS, Jammu to CPWD. Accordingly, on the basis of utilization details provided by CPWD as on 31st March 23, an amount of Rs.875,67,00,000 has been debited to Work in Progress & corresponding effect to the tune of Rs.879,99,00000- has been given to Capital Fund. In respect of balance amount of Rs.43200000/- lying with CPWD, utilisation details have not been provided and as such shown as advance to the agency in the financial statements annexed hereto.
7. An amount of Rs. 99,308 which was collected by AIIMS, New Delhi on account of Admission Fees during the year 2021-22 was transferred by AIIMS, New Delhi during the year 2022-23. The said income was not accounted for during the year 2021-22 & therefore the same has been directly credited to Corpus Fund during the year.

8. The following amounts which were payable as on 31.03.2022 were not reflected in books of account of AIIMS, Vijaypur during the last financial year:-

Accordingly, the above grant heads have been re classified & necessary rectification entries have been made during the current year by debiting the Capital/Corpus Fund & crediting the specified earmarked funds.

10. Contingency Advance given by mentor institute AIIMS Rishikesh to AIIMS Jammu amounting to Rs. 33,13,794 was standing in the books of accounts of AIIMS Vijaypur as on 31.03.2022. However, the entire amount was expended during the financial year 2021-22 by AIIMS, Vijaypur which had remained unadjusted in books during the year. The same has been adjusted during the current year by passing adjustment entry through Capital/Corpus Fund.

11. Committed liability amounting to Rs. 62,05,284 was standing under the head Current liabilities as on 01.04.2022. Out of the same, expenses amounting to Rs. 56,23,284 were adjusted during the year 2021-22. However, the details of expenses of balance amount of Rs.5,82,000 standing as on 31.03.2022 is still not available and is therefore carried forward under the head current liabilities as on 31.03.2023.

12. Balance of Rs.1,52,682 was standing in Treasury Single Account (TSA) as on 31.03.2023 out of which Rs. 1,52,078 was on account of TDS & GST Payable on transactions pertaining to Swachhya Action Plan (SAP). However, the account could not be debited for payment of taxes on 31.03.2023 and the entire amount lapsed on the close of the financial year. Accordingly, the closing balance of Rs. 1,52,682 in TSA has been reversed and corresponding adjustment has been made through Capital/Corpus Fund.

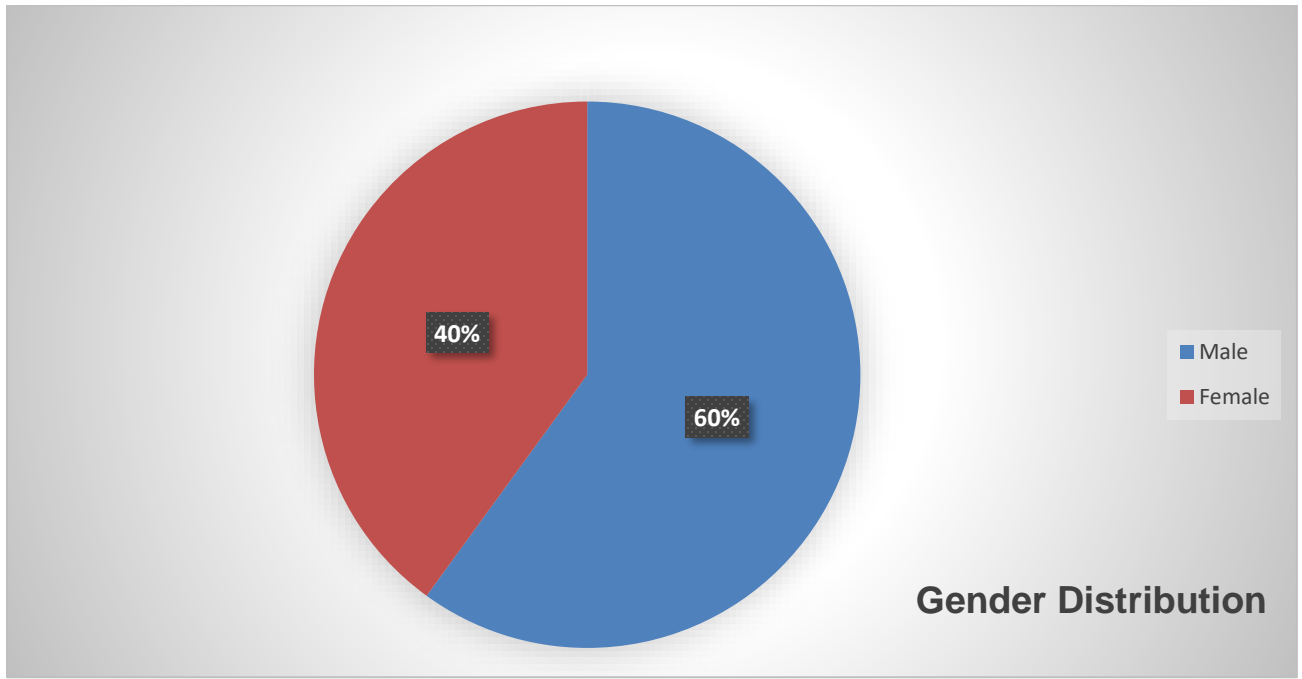

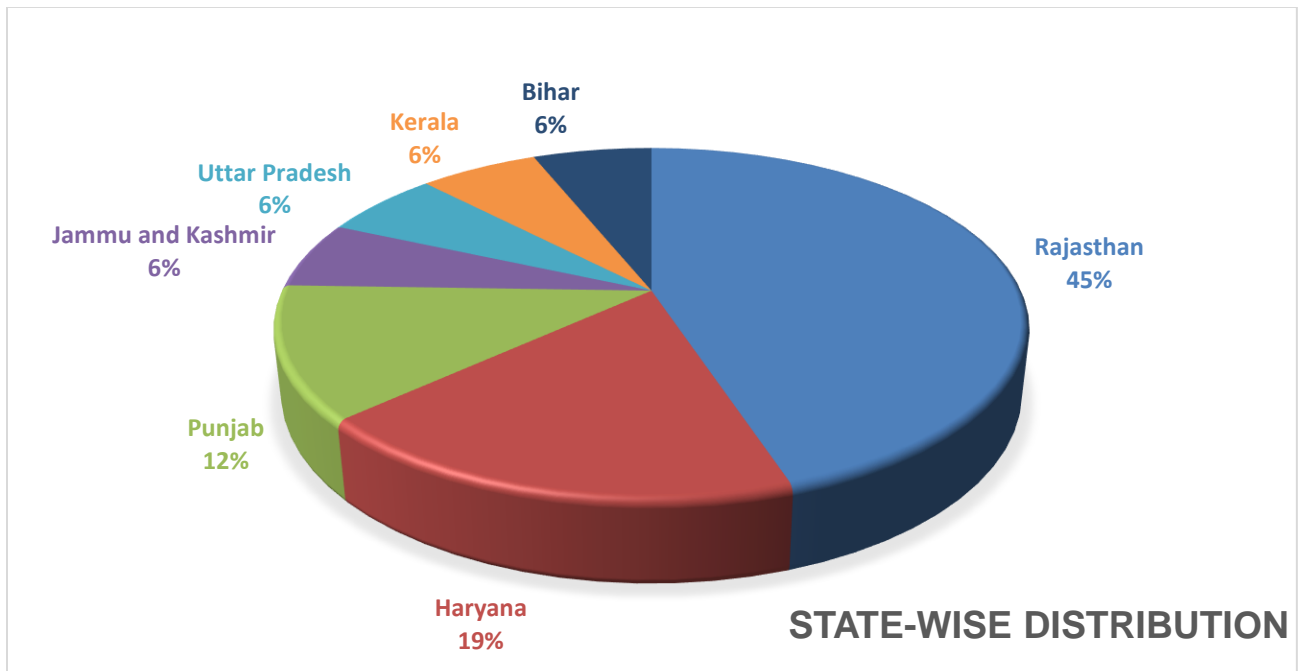

State-wise Distribution (MBBS Batch 2020-21)



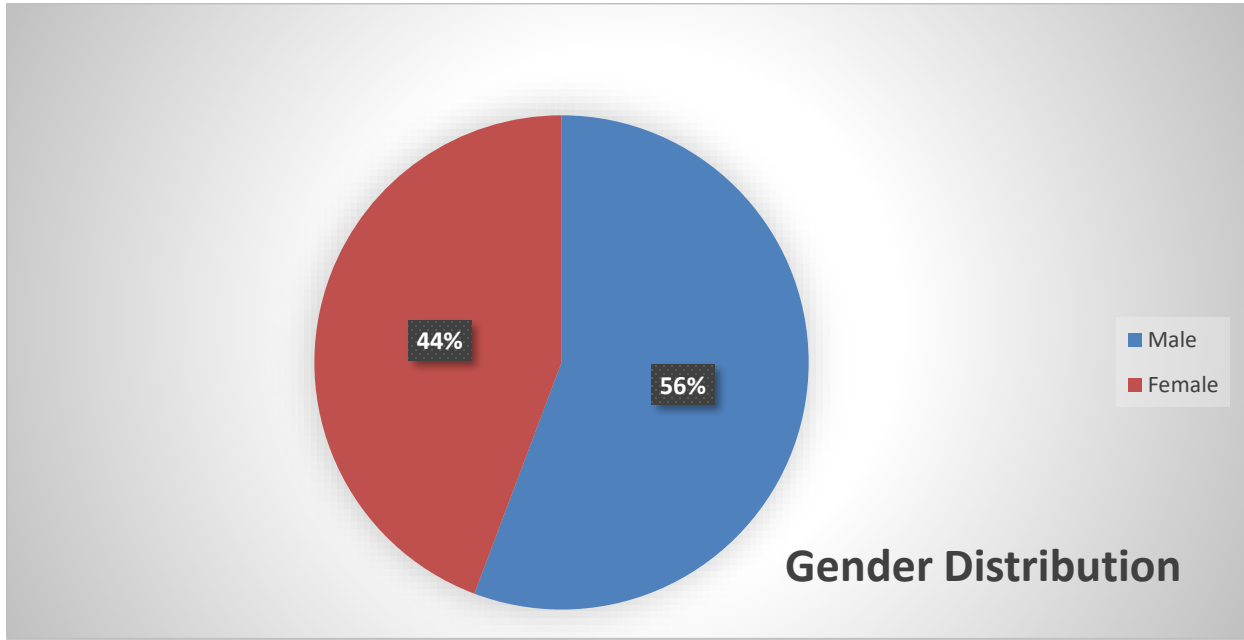

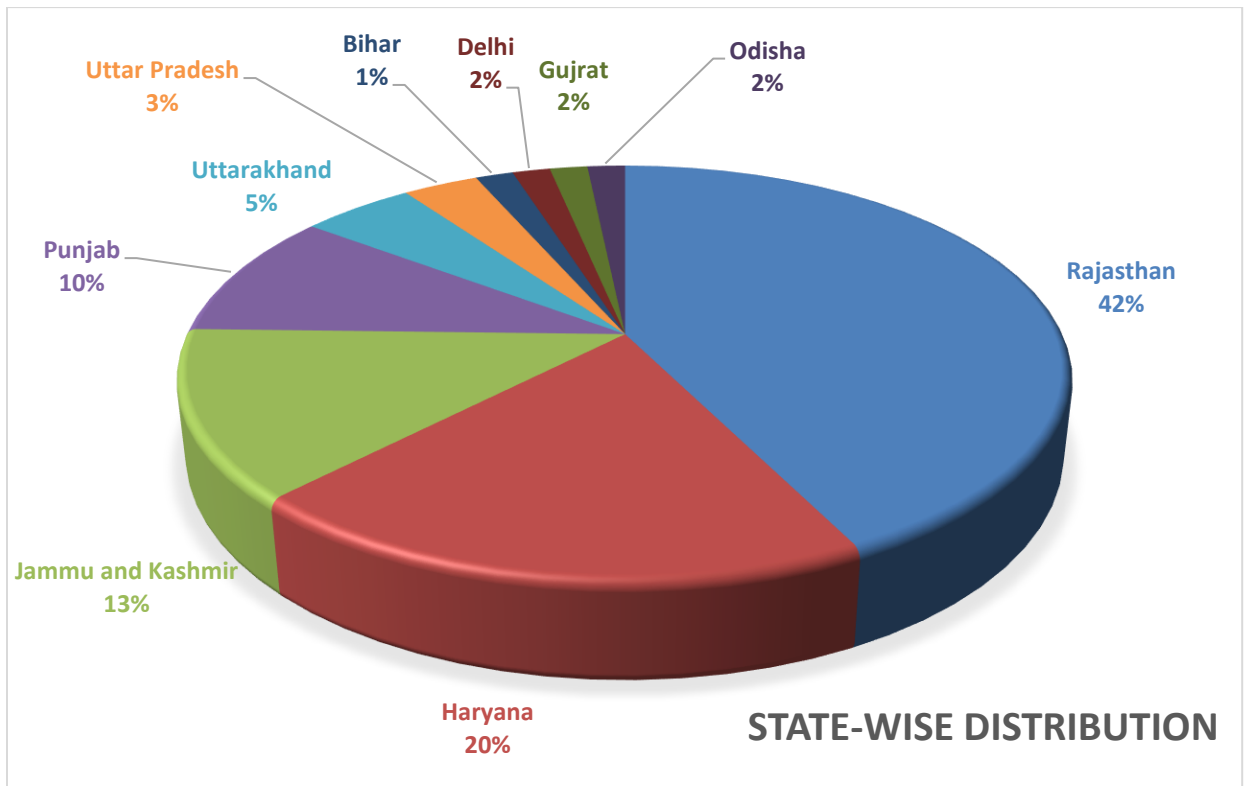

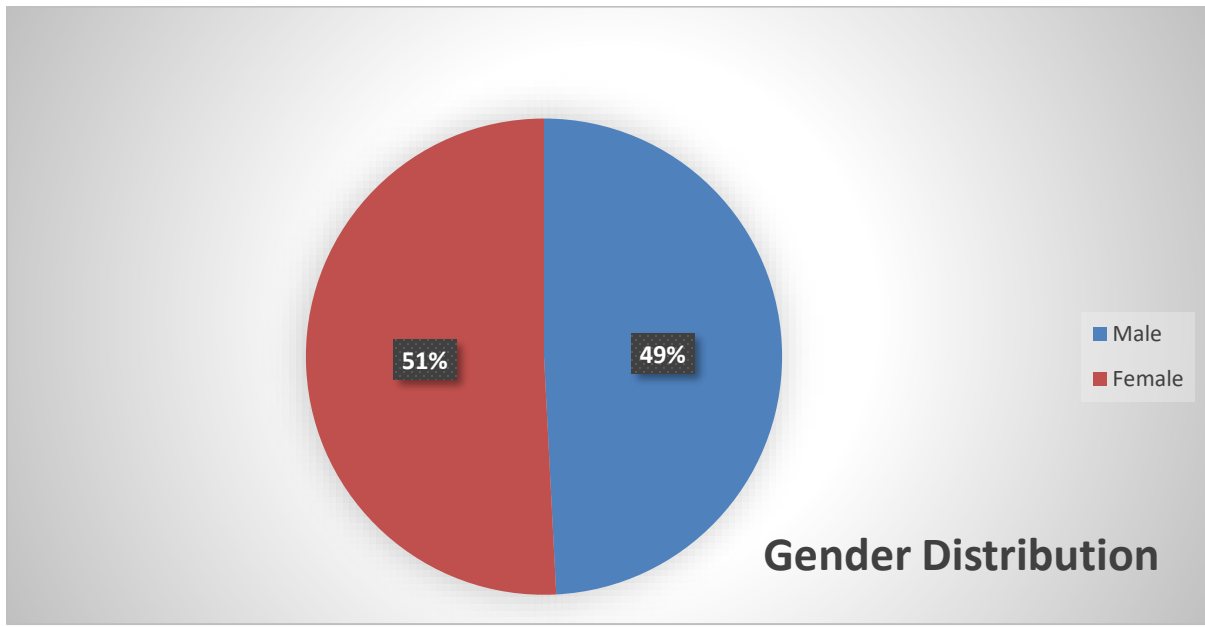

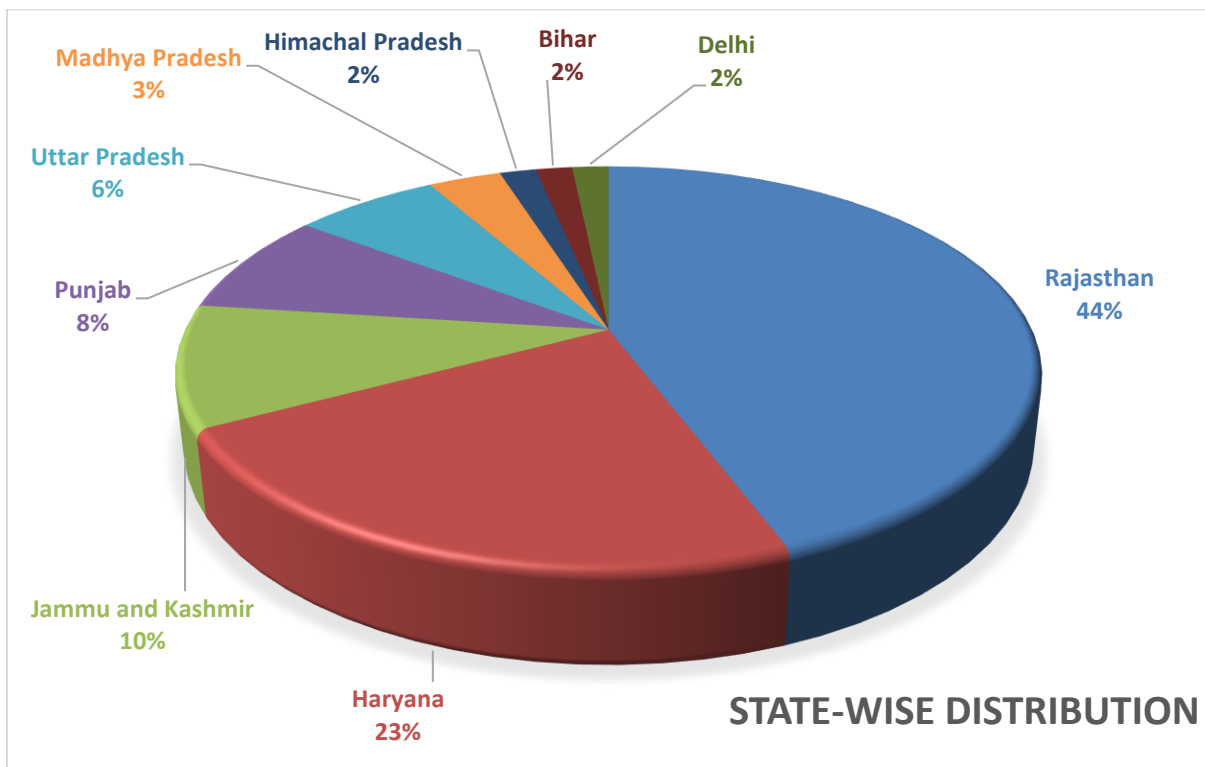

PROGRESS OF CONSTRUCTION OF AIIMS, VIJAYPUR, JAMMU

Construction Progress of AIIMS Jammu

The foundation stone of AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu was laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji on 03rd February 2019. It was followed by Bhoomi Poojan Ceremony by Dr Jitendra Singh, Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge) of the Ministry of Earth Sciences, Minister of State (Independent Charge) of Science & Technology, Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office, Minister of State in the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Minister of State in the Department of Atomic Energy and Minister of State in the Department of Space, Government of India on 13th February 2020. AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu is still in its construction phase as in year 2020-21 and progressing satisfactorily with increase of manpower from 500 labours (due to COVID-19 pandemic) to approximately 3500 labours, working day and night to complete the project. **Photographs of progress of construction activities as on 31st May 2022 & 30th March 2023 are attached as Annexure-XXII).** AIIMS, Vijaypur, Jammu shall be a 750 bedded hospital in phase-I, with multiple specialities as well as super speciality departments (32 specialty and 18 super speciality departments). SAMBA: Union Secretary, Health and Family Welfare (H&FW), Rajesh Bhushan, on Monday visited All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Jammu being constructed at Vijaypur and inspected various development works under execution in the premier health center.

Union Secretary was apprised of present status of construction works being done in the upcoming AIIMS through a detailed presentation. He was informed that 45% of civil

and other infrastructure works have been completed and rest of the construction works scheduled to completed by April 2023.

The complete project consists of two phases including hospital building, medical college, hostels, residential quarters and other utilities. The premier health institution is being established with a sanctioned cost of Rs. 1661 crore including Rs. 1452 crore for medical college and other infrastructure besides Rs. 209 crore for latest technology based medical equipments and

related material.

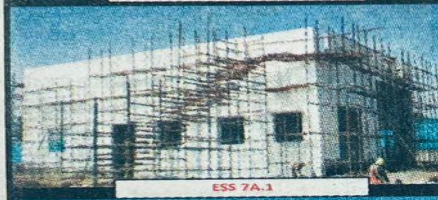

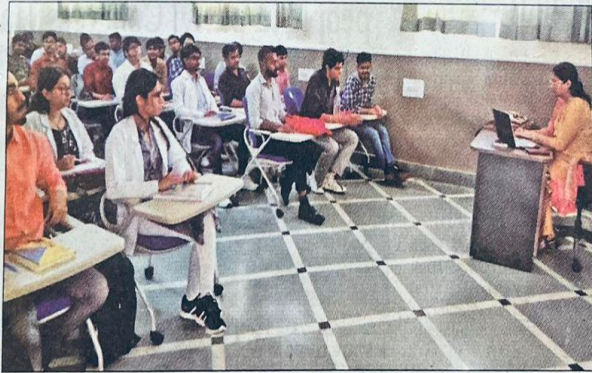

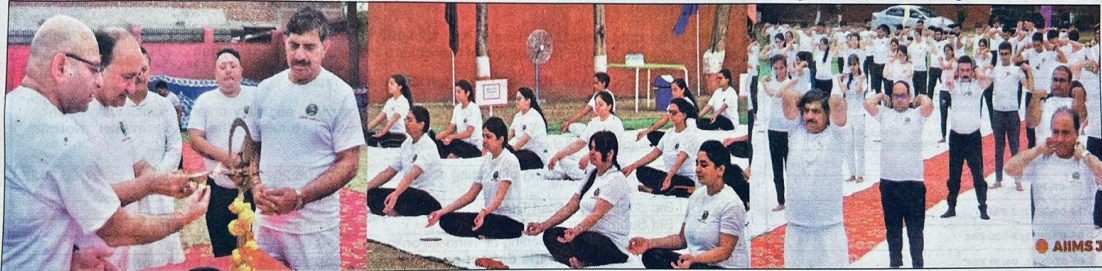
