IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING IN EXAMINATION

1. Candidates must follow all instructions from the Supervisor (Controller of Examination / Invigilator). Any candidate who does not follow such instructions, their examination may be invalidated. Non-compliance with the Supervisor's directions may also result in suspension from examinations.
2. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre without Admit Card and institution ID Card.
3. The photograph on the form and admit card should be latest (not more than 6 months old) and preferably against a light background.
4. Communication devices like Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphone, smart watch, Health Band etc are prohibited in the examination hall. In case any candidate is found in possession of any of the aforesaid prohibited items inside the centre, it will be considered as the use of unfair means and action will be taken against the candidate in accordance with the relevant provisions.
5. Candidates are requested to be seated in their respective seats at least 15 min before the scheduled start time of the examination.
6. Breaks for nature's call are permitted once after 1 hour of the start of the examination. Only one candidate may take a break at any given time. However, no candidates will be allowed for nature's call during the last 30 Minutes of the examination.
7. Candidates must not communicate with another candidate or anyone else other than supervisory staff during an examination. If there is a need to raise a point of immediate urgency, the candidate must raise a hand to attract the Supervisor's attention. The candidate may then explain the matter in a quiet and non-disruptive manner.
8. Abusive behaviour in exam centres will not be tolerated. Any candidate in breach of this will be asked to leave the exam room immediately. This may also result in the suspension of sitting further exams.
9. The candidate must indicate examination completion to the Supervisor by raising a hand and remaining seated until the Supervisor has collected all examination materials, other than the candidate's personal material.
