At the outset, Prof (Dr) Shakti Kumar Gupta, Executive Director and CEO, AIIMS Jammu welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman and also introduced Dr Sanjeev Jain, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu who was recently nominated by the Central Government in place of Prof Manoj Dhar, Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu.

The Chairman welcomed Dr Sanjeev Jain, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu and also others Members including Special Invitees. It was emphasized by the Chairman that for a meaningful discussion and transaction of the business, Members should go through the agenda items.

The Chairman further suggested that regular meetings of the Institute Body, Governing Body and other Committees should be held as has been prescribed in the AIIMS Regulations. The mechanism of either post-facto approval or transaction of business by circulation may be avoided unless otherwise the situation demands.

AGENDA ITEM NO GB-01/03

PRESENTATION ON THE PROGRESS OF AIIMS JAMMU BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & CEO, AIIMS JAMMU

The Executive Director & CEO, AIIMS Jammu made a presentation on the progress of AIIMS Jammu by highlighting the important administrative and academic events, achievements and major developments of the Institute. He also flagged the issues and challenges existing/likely to emerge in the commissioning of AIIMS Jammu.

The Governing Body expressed their full satisfaction with the progress of AIIMS Jammu. Despite having inadequate staff, the contribution and commitment of the entire faculty was highly appreciated. Their involvement in the planning of the Labs, Wards, OTs, etc was commendable. The smooth and efficient running of the Undergraduates for three MBBS Batch students was noted. The Governing Body took the following decisions:

1. To expedite the construction and the completion of the project for a timely commissioning including dry running of the systems by October 2023.

- 1.1. Commitment in writing from CPWD should be taken about Phase wise completion and handing over the buildings/Units for use.
- 1.2. Before handing over, all the statutory clearances should be taken by the CPWD.
- 1.3. HITES, engaged for supply of equipment should be prompted and directed, directly as well as through Ministry for timely supply of the equipment so that they can be installed in time without being a bottleneck for the completion of the project.
- 2. Substantial number of non-faculty posts are still to be approved by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. It was emphasised by all the Members that these posts are essential for the functioning of the Hospital and hence, persons to these posts should be in place prior to commissioning of the Institute. Accordingly, a request is to be forwarded to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India to get the Proposal for creation of the posts cleared as soon as possible. It was further decided to identify critical/essential posts required for the operationalization of the Institute and recruit the required manpower at the earliest through internal diversion of the non-functional posts which are already sanctioned to AIIMS Jammu without having any additional financial implication.
- 3. To target for readiness of 750 beds for commissioning.
- 4. Seats for 4th MBBS batch to be fixed at 62 Nos and thereafter the MBBS seats should be decided according to the infrastructure and facilities available in the Institute.
- 5. To frequently take feedback on student satisfaction.
- 6. Electric Vehicles/Battery vehicles, routes, parking etc to be finalised before the date of commissioning.
- 7. To seek clarifications from the concerned authorities on the functioning essentials required for activating the Helipad being built at AIIMS Jammu, especially Traffic Clearance Management and Manpower requirement.
- 8. Digitization of AIIMS Jammu to be made a priority.
- 9. It was emphasised that while creating Centre of Excellence, existing guidelines should be adhered to and, if required, it can further be improved upon.
- 10. To go ahead on nomination basis directly with CPWD for the establishment of Digital Library at AIIMS Jammu.

POST-FACTO APPROVAL OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF STANDING SELECTION COMMITTEE FOR SELECTION OF REGULAR FACULTY AGAINST SANCTIONED POSTS IN THE INSTITUTE

Eighty (80) Candidates were selected on the recommendations of the Standing Selection Committee. The process and methodology including recommendation of Standing Selection Committee were approved post-facto.

However, as and when required based on the functional necessity the appointing authorities at AIIMS are competent to frame recruitment rules including its amendments.

ESTABLISHMENT OF COLLEGE OF NURSING AT AIMS JAMMU AND ADOPTION OF RECRUITMENT RULES OF AIMS NEW DELHI OR ANY OTHER AIMS IN THE COUNTRY FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF POSTS IN COLLEGE OF NURSING

The Governing Body approved the proposal for establishment of College of Nursing at AIIMS Jammu.

The Governing Body perused the Recruitment Rules of AIIMS New Delhi and decided that the grade of post with their corresponding Recruitment Rules which are in vogue at New Delhi are adopted.

It was further decided that, for a uniform pattern of staffing in the Nursing College with respect to grade of post, their designation, age, experience and qualification a specific agenda needs to be put before the Academic Committee.

ESTABLISHMENT OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT BOARD (PMDB) AT AIMS JAMMU ON THE LINES OF AIMS NEW DELHI

The Governing Body being aware of the current state of development and its upcoming decided that there has to be an Ad-hoc Committee constituted with experts as its Members in planning, monitoring and commissioning of different project works both for the current and the future ones. The Governing Body was also briefed about the existence of the Project Management Committee monitoring the current ongoing projects. From the short comings of the existing Committee composition of the PMC and to make it more efficient and effective, the Governing Body decided to constitute **Project Management and Development Board (PMDB)** with the following composition:

- Superintendent Engineer, AIIMS Member
- Faculty I/c Projects (Projects Officer) Convener
- Experts from the field of Architecture, Engineering, Planning and Public Health may be co-opted/invited by the Chairman.

It was further decided that the AIIMS Administration should work out Standard Operating Procedures for PMDP including safe record keeping of its documents.

ESTABLISHMENT OF IT DEPARTMENT AT AIIMS JAMMU

The Governing Body Members felt the necessity of having an IT facility for smooth and efficient management of different services at the Institute. As a service concept, it further decided instead of making a department, it should be an IT Division (IT-D). In an Institute like AIIMS, Department & Units are Academic concepts and Divisions & Cells are Service/Administrative concepts. This approach will avoid ambiguity in the future.

However, the Governing Body desired that to rationalize the fee structure in line with the current situation (New patterns of Medical Education, use of technology and kind of skill required in public health) the fee structure may be revised in line with other Institutes of National Importance. A specific agenda is required to be put before Standing Academic Committee to deliberate on it and advise the Institute.

CREATION OF POSTS OF MEDICAL PHYSICIST AT AIIMS JAMMU

AIIMS Jammu is going to install state of the art and high-end machinery and equipment in various labs. There are labs where radiation is involved in the delivery of the services

and these labs cannot be established without having inhouse Physicist as per the statutory requirements. Also, Governing Body observed there has been no sanctioned post to fulfil the same. In order, not to have gaps nor deficiencies in establishing the health care services at the earliest at the Institute, we may internally divert three seats of Junior Residents (Level-10) to be operated as Medical Physicist (Level-10). As and when posts are sanctioned, they will be diverted back to original position. This arrangement will not have financial escalation and as such with the current state of development these three posts of Junior Residents can effectively be utilised.

On similar lines if necessary, considering the essentiality and critical nature of the Institute, the Director may consider similar kind of arrangement for different areas of functioning for time being without having any additional financial implication.

AUTHORIZATION OF EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & CEO OF AIIMS, VIJAYPUR, JAMMU TO APPROVE THE ANNUAL ACCOUNTS OF THE INSTITUTE

The Members perused the AIIMS Act & Regulations. This provision is quite clear that only audited statement of Accounts by the CAG shall be put to the SFC not vice versa. The Governing Body urged the Director to act accordingly. If necessary, the administration may give a suitable reply back to the Office of CAG accordingly.
